## Tornadoes in Colorado?

Although not as frequent as we've seen in Oklahoma, Colorado does experience tornadoes and we should all be prepared with a plan in case disaster strikes.

Here are some tips to keep in mind:

1) Discuss with all family members the safest place of your home to meet. This is usually the basement or an interior room such as the closet or a bathroom.

2) Designate a family member

or friend who does not live in the area as the point of contact in case you are separated from each other.

3) Keep a copy of important documents in a safe place off site from your home such as a bank or at your work office.

4) Teach everyone in the family old enough and physically capable on how to shut off utilities such as water and electricity.

5) Keep a well stocked first aid kit in your safe place. This

includes not only traditional items such as bandages and antibiotic ointments but also a supply of critical medications.

6) Keep a disaster kit. This would include bottled water, canned food, flashlights with extra batteries and a supply of cash. An extra change of clothes for each family member could also be nice. When I lived in OK, we also kept a spare set of shoes to protect our feet in case we needed to climb through debris.
